CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 65 DECLARATION

This declaration is issued by Arlo Technologies, Inc. in connection with its products sold or distributed in California.

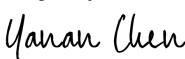
California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, commonly known as Proposition 65, requires businesses to provide a clear and reasonable warning before knowingly and intentionally exposing California consumers to chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm, unless an applicable exemption or safe-harbor level applies. OEHHA's safe-harbor levels include No Significant Risk Levels (NSRLs) for carcinogens and Maximum Allowable Dose Levels (MADLs) for reproductive toxicants.

Based on Arlo's current restricted substance compliance program, supplier due diligence process, and representative product assessments, Arlo has determined that the covered Arlo products addressed by this declaration are not expected to require a Proposition 65 warning under applicable law. Accordingly, Arlo Technologies, Inc. understands that no Proposition 65 warning is required to be provided with the covered products or their packaging, receipt, or order confirmation materials.

Arlo Technologies, Inc. continues to monitor Proposition 65 listings, safe-harbor levels, and related regulatory developments, and will review newly listed chemicals and any relevant changes in product composition, materials, or exposure conditions as part of its ongoing compliance program.

The current Proposition 65 chemical list and safe-harbor information are maintained by OEHHA (Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment).
